

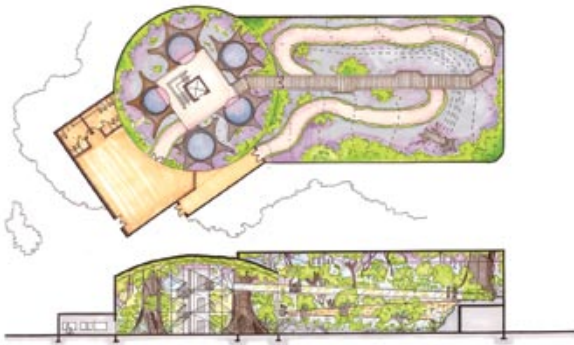


Over the next 10 years, phased implementation of the Master Plan will bring about major new exhibits, animal enclosures, and facilities to this compact 23.5 acre Delaware Park footprint. Dramatic renovation and improvements to the Zoo's historic structures and existing buildings are also scheduled to take place.

# Master Plan



Buffalo Zoo, Buffalo, NY



The \$70 million Master Plan incorporates an interpretive theme of water and its relationship to Buffalo, Erie County and the Great Lakes. It includes a new Entry Plaza adjacent to the existing parking lot with a Sea Lion and River Otter Exhibit. The entry will be transformed into a "Dining-with-the-Animals" Experience with direct views into the new Asian River and Highlands Exhibits. The South American Rainforest Building will house a year-round tropical forest. Other exhibits include the African Watering Hole, the Arctic Edge Polar Bear Exhibit, and Wonders of Water, an Interactive Children's Exhibit.
