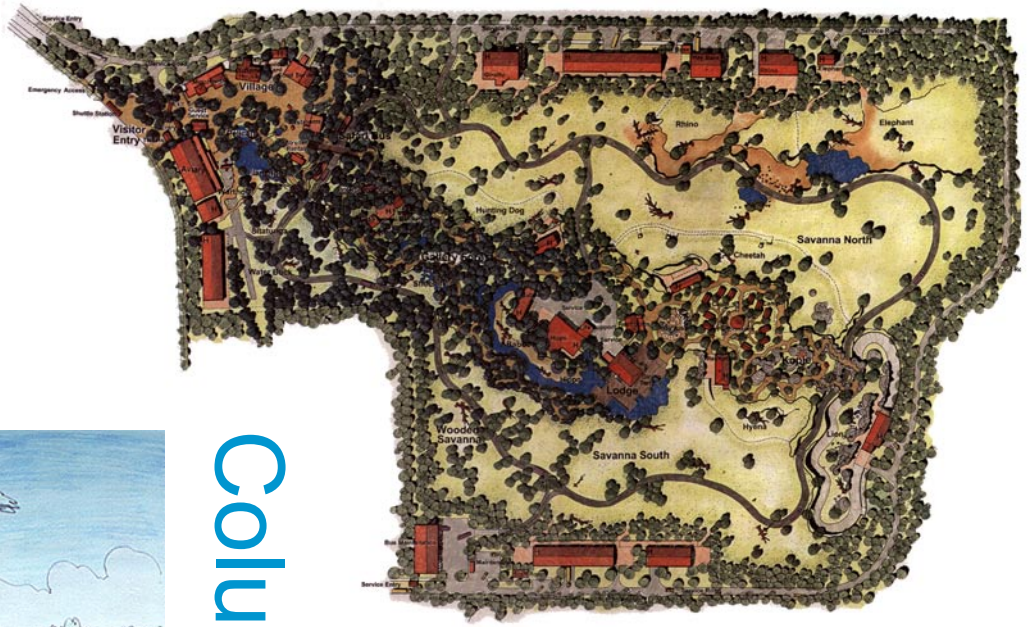

African Plains

Adjacent to the existing zoo, the East Africa Plains project includes 65 acres of simulated East African habitats. A visitor's journey begins in a village overlooking a small lake with flamingos and pelicans. Warthogs burrow in an abandoned airstrip. In the village guests pass through the Customs House where they receive a passport. From the village, visitors embark on a bus safari through wooded and grassy savannas and kopje habitats. There is also a walking path that leads through a gallery forest to the lodge, serving refreshments. Rested visitors can walk from the lodge to the kopje and interpretive playground.
