The new exhibits encompass a five acre redesign of existing exhibit space and include new animal exhibits for leopard and tiger. The experience will be one that is sympathetic with the natural habitat of the animals. The precinct also includes a recently renovated Orangutan exhibit. The new exhibit will be the first phase of a larger Asian precinct at the zoo incorporating architecture, natural landscape features, fauna, flora, geology, and architectural elements that immerses visitors in an Asian forest environment. Leopards will be exhibited in a mesh enclosure while tigers will roam an open exhibit with a shallow pool and waterfall. Future planned exhibits include an enlarged gibbon enclosure, renovated tapir exhibit, red panda enclosures, and a bird aviary.
