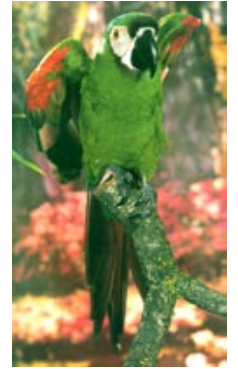




# South America Exhibit



## Jurong Bird Park, Jurong, Singapore

The exhibit design builds on the foundation set in the master plan by PJA. While the landscape design takes advantage of the tropical climate of Singapore to present an immersive and authentic South American jungle, the visitor experience is dominated by the water features chosen to represent the birds and wildlife of one of the big river deltas of the continent.

Visitors will cross a flamingo lagoon, encounter parrots feeding on the clay banks of the river, visit an indigenous stilt village connected by wooden walkways that offer close views of the capybaras living among the water plants and various water birds exploring the pool on their stilt legs.

A shaded viewing shelter offers quiet underwater views of diving waterfowl, snapping turtles, and colorful fresh water rays, and glimpses of brockett deer in the background. The visitors emerge from the jungle to encounter a Colombian hacienda offering refreshments, an adjacent themed playground and the maize-maze.
