## South America Exhibit



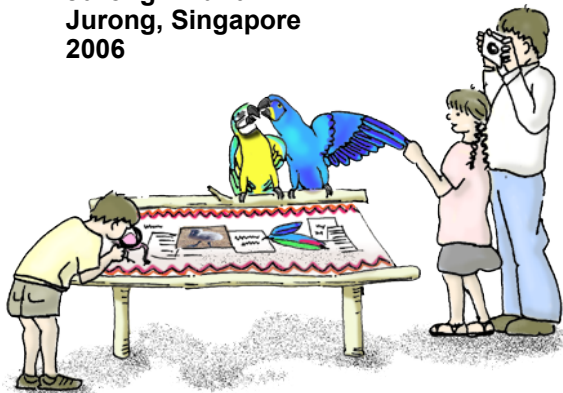
The Interpretive Master Plan was developed in conjunction with the design of the new South America exhibit, Jardín de Sur America, by PJA.

Following the path around the flamingo laguna, through the jungle garden and across the capybara pond, passing the underwater viewing of water birds, parents and children reach the Colombian hacienda offering refreshments, the maize-maze and a stable-themed playground.

On the way the visitors can hatch a flamingo egg, dig in the sand with different excavator beaks, climb the tree house, try on masks and learn about the jungle plants. Animal ID-Signage and interpretive signs include special information for children.

The design of the interactive displays takes care to involve the whole family and providing group interaction.
