PJA remodeled the entry area of Oakland Zoo to capture the atmosphere of Lamu, a historic Port City on the island Lamu off the coast of Kenya.

The African theme integrates the entry complex with the already existing and adjoining East Africa Exhibits.

The program included a fast-food-style restaurant with indoor and outdoor dining areas, a gift shop, visitor restrooms, tickets booths, and cash control rooms.

Graphics and signage mimic authentic signs of the streetscape of Lamu and were also developed by the PJA team.
