

With the Adventure Challenge the Singapore Zoo adds a major new family attraction to its venue.

The first part of the area is given over to live interaction with domestic animals and pets. Visitors can watch animal shows and admire the feats of trained pets in the amphitheater. In the animal contact zone, children can interact with domestic animals like goats, chicken, donkeys and rabbits, and learn from experienced staff about the best way to make a home for a pet.

Enter the second part of the adventure at the water plaza surrounded by the restaurant and birthday pavilions. Here children can climb waterfalls, navigate kayaks down a whitewater river and boat on a lake. In addition, the adventure trail starts here, organized like a real-life computer game - you have to master one challenge to enter the next one. Hidden shortcuts keep everybody in the game even when they need to circumvent one of the adventures.

Visitors travel over floating lily pads and log bridges entering the jungle to reach Piranha Lake which they cross on a raft. They built shelters, sail on a zip line over the crocodile-infested mud swamp, and a rope climb leads the children into a cave.

The path up and around the central mountain lets the visitors discover insects, spiders, and reptiles in naturalistic habitats. After climbing the tower to the top, a slide shoots the delighted children all the way down the mountain.
